Cancellations

Cancellation requires a 3-day notice before the start of the seminar to qualify for a refund (less a \$25 administrative fee). Split location attendance and transfers are discouraged but if necessary are permitted on a space available basis and require a \$50 administrative fee. In the event of cancellation due to adverse weather, registrants may 1) transfer to a later seminar, or 2) receive full credit for registration at a seminar the following year.

Seminar Schedule

Sign-in begins at 7:45 a.m. Instruction begins at 8:00 a.m. and concludes at 5:00 p.m with a one-hour lunch break. Instruction is broken down into 50 to 90 minute sections by topic with 10-minute breaks.
